- article regarding the need for better fire protection after big fire
- April 14, 1892
- 2 copies

JSC v.2-1300-02 Big Fire at Bond Head

- 'Business portion destroyed'
- Feb.4, 1892

JSC v.2-1300-03 Big Fire of 1871, That Nearly Wiped Out Bradford, Recalled

- reprint of *South Simcoe News Extra*
- 5 pages

JSC v.2-1300-04 Bradford Again Visited by the Fire Fiend

- *The Witness*, Dec. 29, 1887
- '8 Business Places Consumed'
- fire on main street

JSC v.2-1300-05 Bradford Destroyed by Fire

- *Newmarket Era*, May 26, 1871
- '125 Houses Burned – Loss \$500,000'
- 10 pages (overlapping copies)

JSC v.2-1300-06 Fire in Bradford

- *The Newmarket Era*, Sept. 1864
- fire broke out in Small's Hotel (late J. Bingham's)
- 3 copies

JSC v.2-1300-07 Fire! Fire!

- *The Witness*, Thurs., May 8, 1890
- 'The Western Hotel and Mr. G. Cook's Store is ashes'
- 2 copies

JSC v.2-1300-08 Fireworks!

- May 18, 1958
- information about a fire (headline illegible)
- property owners' loss and insurance listed
- 11 pages, multiple copies

JSC v.2-1300-09 Looking Backward

- June 17, 1901
- rebuilding after 1871 fire
- 2 copies

JSC v.2-1300-10 Looking Backward

- Sept. 26, 1901
- information on 1871 fire
- 4 copies

JSC v.2-1300-11 Looking Backward

- October 10, 1901
- 'Synopsis of the action of the several public meetings...on our late disastrous fire'

- notes from July 28, 1871, Jan. 19, 1872, Oct. 1873, Sept. 16, 1864
