

Paul Paxton Seriously Injured In Triple Crash

Paul Paxton, 29, of Newmarket, and brother of Leo. Paxton of Dunkerron and Mrs. William Moriarty, is in Peel Memorial Hospital, Brampton, in critical condition with head injuries, suffered in a triple crash at a bridge on Highway 50 near Woodhill, in the Bolton district, on Thursday of last week.

William Walker, 23, driver of the car, was killed when his car and a dump truck, said to have been driven by Luigi Gallow of Toronto, collided. The driver of the dump truck escaped injury but his truck burst into flames.

Paul Paxton was driving a tractor-trailer, loaded with steel, and when he attempted to avoid the other two vehicles in the accident, his heavy load rolled over, critically injuring him.

Although his head injuries are severe, Mr. Paxton is conscious and has not suffered any signs of paralysis, which are two very encouraging signs, however doctors say his condition will be critical for several more days.

Mr. Paxton's wife and four young children live in Newmarket.
