November 25, 1991

Length: 1 hour, 33 minutes and 51 seconds

[*The interviewer is not introduced but it can be assumed that Joe Saint is speaking.*] Joe and Bill share their memories of the Holland Marsh and Bradford West Gwillimbury area. They discuss community members and give many anecdotal details about them and the area. Bill discusses his upbringing in England and how he arrived in Canada. Mae reads aloud from a history that has been written about Bill. It includes details about when he came to Canada, where he lived in West Gwillimbury and Bradford, his marriage, his career, and community involvement. The history also details Mae's career in nursing and accounting and her community involvement.
