To municipalities paying their County levies or any part thereof on or before September 30th a discount of Two per cent will be allowed. To municipalities paying their levies on or before October 31st a discount of one per cent will be allowed. Municipalities not paying their levies on or before Dec. 31st will be charged interest at the rate of Six per cent per annum This does not apply to the Ontario Government War Tax which must be paid on or before December 31st.

BY-LAW NO. 1537

A By-law to authorize the Treasurer to give the several Municipalities a discount if their County levy is paid in advance.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient that a by-law should be passed authorizing the County Treasurer to give discounts to the several municipalities who pay their County levy in advance.

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the County of Simcoe, in Council assembled, enacts as follows :

That the municipalities paying their County levy on or before the 20th day of August in each year the County Treasurer shall give a discount of 2 per cent.

That to municipalities paying their County levies on or before the 20th day of October in each year the County Treasurer shall give a discount of 1 per cent.

That to municipalities not paying their County levies on or before the 20th day of December in each year the County Treasurer shall charge interest at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum.

That this by-law shall come into force and take effect from and after the final passing thereof.
