CIRCULAR TO MUNICIPAL CLERKS

Toronto, June 1st, 1918.

Clerks of Municipalities are requested to furnish the statistics called for in the following schedule and return them to the undersigned on or before the first day of July.

Please compare the entries with statistics of previous years. If necessary, please revise the additions of the assessor. A frequent source of error lies in the recapitulation of the rolls.

Two copies of schedule are furnished, one of which is to be filled up and returned in the enclosed envelope. The other may be filled up by the clerk and kept for future reference.

To insure safe delivery of returns the Municipal Act contains the following words: "and every such return shall be transmitted by registered post."
