The Corporation of the Village of Bradford hereby promises to pay to CLARENCE H. WOOD of the Township of West Gwillimbury in the County of Simcoe, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns the sum of Five Thousand Two hundred and fifty-eight 07/100 Dollars as follows -- the sum of \$584.23 on the *25th* day of *August* 1925 and a further like sum on the *25th* day of *August* in each and every year thereafter for Eight consecutive years being in all nine equal payments of \$584.24 each together with interest on said sum or any part thereof after maturity at the rate of 6% per annum

until paid.

All sums due hereunder to be payable at the Office of "The Standard Bank of Canada" in said Village of Bradford.

DATED at the Village of Bradford this 24th day of August, 1923.



Dear Mr. Green:

Replying to your favor of December 17th, first of all I want to thank you very heartily for your kind inquiry regarding the state of the brother's and my health. I am glad to be able to advise that both of us are well on the road to complete recovery.

Now regarding your account, we have your check for \$172.10, but according to the brother, our accountant, this is not correct and he has made out a detailed statement of your account which shows a net balance still coming to us of \$207.61.

I made out a memo the same night I had the pleasure meeting your Council, to make an adjustment, and so far as my memory serves me, this was along the following lines,-

We were to give you a credit of \$100.00 by reason of the absence of the gooseneck and of the shafts and pole. We were also to take off the Sales Tax on the Ford Chassis, amounting to \$27.90. Again, we were to supply you with two Underwriter Playpipes as part of the original Equipment - and without charge. Also a Switch was sent the day after I returned, to Mr. Coombs.

All these items have been mentioned in the enclosed statement and I would suggest that you consult the original contract and check everything over and if we are right, a further check would not be unacceptable. If we are wrong, please say where.



"RE FIRE ENGINE DEBENTURES"

This is to advise that pursuant to the instructions received from the Town Council I have completed a sale of the outstanding Debentures issued under authority of By-law 481, to Mr. C. H. Wood, The original principal was \$4300.00, the amount of principal included in the first debenture, already matured, was \$326.23, so that the principal outstanding since the 24th of August 1924 was \$3973.77. The interest on this amount from the above date at 6% to the 15th of May would be \$172.40, but as this will not be payable until the 24th of August, its present value would be \$170.00, making a total of \$4143.77 as of the 15th of May 1925. I have prepared and hand you herewith for execution by the Corporation Agreement covering these payments and I am prepared to hand you a cheque upon the completion of the above documents.



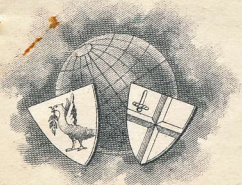
