

Public Library To Open First Of Next Month

The space in the town hall given for the public library has been transformed from a dirty, dark corner into a bright, attractively decorated, and well planned library room which is expected to be ready for opening by June 1.

The library room is in the north-west corner of the hall and a walk has been laid around the west side of the building to the entrance door on the west side. The big double doors on the north have been closed, leaving a window into the library room.

The room itself is small, but, for its size, the amount of shelving space is remarkable, with not a possible inch being allowed to waste. The distance between shelves, is adjustable and the shelves have all been finished in natural tone of the wood. The walls and ceiling are green, with a brown wainscoting, and the floors are in green and fawn colored tile. A door has been opened into the Council Chamber, which, upon occasions, may be used when additional space is required. The committee which looked after the arrangements for this room, Messrs. Glenn Boyd and F. C. Cook, deserve much credit for the excellence of the arrangements in a limited space.

In addition to the library room, the kitchen at the town hall is being completely redecorated.

Miss Gillbank, an experienced librarian, is here to assist Miss Birdie Webb, librarian, in getting the library organized, and they have also had the old library books cleaned and repaired. In addition certain library services have been arranged.
