## ***R.C.M.P. offices open***

On Thursday, September 19th, dignitaries and guests sat outside the newly-completed Headquarters of the Newmarket R.C.M.P., as flags and banners snapped in the breeze, and officers in the distinctive crimson regimentals of the Mounted Police stood at attention.

They had gathered for the Official Opening of the new facility that will house R.C.M.P. operations, including the new "Integrated Proceeds of Crime Unit", which targets the activities of organized crime.

Commanding Officer, explained why the Headquarters had been moved from downtown Toronto to Newmarket. "One of the beauties of doing federal work in this province is that we have the ability to be here, there, everywhere," Zaccardalli said. "I think we're in Toronto, we're in Newmarket, we're in Kapuskasing - we're everywhere.

"That type of work can really be done from anywhere. It's the values you have, and how you can serve... all the communities, all the citizens of Ontario."
