

PROF. W. H. DAY MEMORIAL TO BE UNVEILED MAY 27

The memorial cairn in honour of the late Professor W. H. Day, whose vision and untiring perseverance were in a large part responsible for the reclamation of the Holland Marsh, will be unveiled on Sunday afternoon, May 27, at two o'clock in front of Bradford town hall.

The ceremony will be attended by representatives from Simcoe County Council and the Tourist and Industrial Committee of that Council, which is responsible for the bronze plaque on the cairn; the members of council from the three municipalities represented on the marsh; by distinguished representatives from the agricultural field; by members of the late Professor Day's family and friends; and, it is hoped, by a large representation of local residents, especially those residing on the marsh and in the Bradford district.
