

# Chief can't sell furniture to town

BRADFORD — Police Chief John Harrison will not be permitted to sell some of his used furniture to the town to be used in the new police station, council decided Monday.

Calling the sale "unethical," Councillor Bill DePueter urged council not to approve the expenditure of \$395 for a used refrigerator, sofa, stove, and coffee table.

"I don't think we should go for that," Mr. DePueter said.

"I don't only think we shouldn't, we're not going to," Mayor Roy Gordon said.

He added that although he is a member of the police committee, he was unaware of the deal which appeared on the monthly bills and accounts.

"It's a bad practice to be buying used furniture from an employee of the town," he said.

A total of \$2,000 had been allocated by the town to pay for furnishing the new police department. The furniture will be purchased elsewhere, council decided.
