

Flt.-Sgt. Ken. Patience Stated Missing Overseas

Word has been received by his mother in Toronto that Flight Sgt. Kenneth Patience is missing after air operations.

Sgt. Patience is the younger son of Mrs. Patience and the late Wm. Patience, the latter a native of South Simcoe who died in Floral, Sask., a number of years ago. After the husband and father's death the family came to Bradford and here Kenneth Patience first attended school. When still in Public school he moved with the family to Toronto about nine years ago.

Sgt. Patience signed up in the RCAF in Toronto in October 1942, graduating from a Manitoba training school in July 1943 and going overseas a few weeks later.

Besides his mother, a sister, Miss Irene, and an older brother, George, reside in Toronto. Friends here will sincerely hope that his mother may soon hear more encouraging news of the young airman.
