

Roads Closed As Result Of Floods

A Department of Highways bulletin announced the following highways closed as a result of the flood in this area:

No. 7 Highway between Brampton and No. 27 Highway.

No. 11 Highway north of Thornhill closed, but Bailey bridge erected.

No. 44 Highway between Cookstown and Barrie, three culverts out.

No. 400 between Barrie and Crown Hill, bridge out at Willow Creek.

No. 400 at Holland Marsh, flooded for 1,300 feet.

No. 400 a mile south of Cookstown, two washouts.

No. 49 Highway, Kleinburg, bridge approaches gone.

No. 27 Highway north and south of Thornton, two culverts gone. (One-way traffic for 300 feet in Bond Head, and one-way traffic between Bond Head and Cookstown for one mile).

No. 12 Highway, Coldwater to Midland, numerous floodings and washouts.
