

Former Local Principal Passes At Midland

The passing of Mr. J. H. Lukes, principal of Bradford Public School more than twenty years ago, and, since leaving here filling a similar position in Midland, occurred in Midland early yesterday morning, November 6. Although not well, Mr. Lukes continued his teaching duties until the end of September. During the past several weeks it was known that he could not recover.

Mr. Lukes married the former Leona Davey of Bradford, and during the intervening years since being resident here he had kept in touch with former friends here during calls at the home of his wife's father and other members of the Davey family. The knowledge of his passing will be received with sorrow by friends here, especially among his former pupils, and sincere sympathy will be felt for Mrs. Lukes and their surviving daughter, Dorothea. The death of their elder daughter, Margaret, occurring less than two years ago, Mrs. Lukes and her daughter have experienced much sorrow.

Funeral arrangements were delayed until hearing from relatives away from home who could not be located immediately, and at time of going to press have not been announced.
