

OBITUARY.—The late Mr. Samuel Manning was born at Old Castle, County Meath, Ireland, about the year 1817. He emigrated to Canada about 1819 and settled on lot 24, con. 5, Tecumseth, and there resided for 20 years. He then moved to the 6th con., lot 18 Tecumseth, and in a short while thereafter married Miss Margaret Sutherland of West Gwillimbury sister to Capt. Thos. Sutherland now a resident of Alliston. Living later at Bond Head for a few years, he managed a hotel there before finally settling on lot 4, con. 6. When here better than a year he lost his first wife. Remaining a widower two years he then married Miss Sharpe, of King Township, who survives him. His only child, a daughter, married Mr. Ingham N. Sharp and now lives in West Toronto Junction. Deceased was a highly respected resident of this township for 40 years and was in his 74th year when called away by death. He had been ill for two months and his death on Monday 25th was not unexpected as he had received a paralytic stroke on Nov. 25th. For 20 years he had been Church-Warden of Christ's Church, Middleton, and for the last three years a devoted and earnest member of Trinity Church, Bond Head, where he will be missed. Rev. T. Ball conducted the funeral services at St. John's Cemetery, Tecumseth, where the interment was witnessed by a large number of friends.
