

Tenders Called For Paving Toronto-Barrie Highway

With grading and much of the controlled access construction completed the Ontario Department of Highways last week called for tenders for 10 miles of paving on the new Toronto - Barrie controlled access highway.

Long under construction but held up by cement shortages for some time, the new highway will be rushed to completion in order to relieve congestion on the Yonge St. route to the north.

Tenders called for provide for the paving of 5.2 miles from Wilson Ave. to No. 7 Highway and for four miles from No. 7 to Maple sideroad. Tenders for other sections will be placed as speedily as possible. The new highway will have four lanes of concrete stretching from Wilson Ave. to Barrie.
